From 21st to 23rd September 2015, Sathya Sai International Organization (SSIOJ) National Sadhana Camp will be held to commemorate the 90th Birthday of Kaliyuga Avathar Bhagwan Sri Sathya Sai Baba & the 40th Anniversary of Sathya Sai International Organization Japan. As the dates coincide with holy Ganesh Chaturthi Festival and Shirdi Sai Baba Birthday, all four holy occasions will be celebrated with once in a life time extraordinary arrangements to enjoy and experience the Divine bliss.

The Pilgrimage site is in the most scenic National park of Shiga Prefecture, located in center of Japan on the shores of "Biwako" the largest lake in Japan, formed 4 million years ago and receives water streams from 118 class "A" rivers. Takashima is one of Shiga's largest cities with Hira Mountains, Shirahige Shrine whose gate is in the lake. The programme includes <u>visits to sacred pilgrim sites</u>, <u>Shirahama beach side summer camps and other attractions being planned</u>. An intelligent programme designed for children and students will be provided, too.

We request you to bring NO ALCOHOL, NO SMOKING, NO NON-VEGETARIAN FOOD.


Caution:

ACCESS to SHIRAHAMASO




From South (From Kyoto/Osaka direction on Koshu Road)

A short while after passing the Shirahige Shrine, you will see the R161 bypass become elevated, but continue on the left lane (to Katsuno direction) without taking the bypass (Photo 1). Make a right turn at the first light Hagi-no-Hamaguchi, or at the second light. The rest is as shown in Photo 3.

From North direction (From the Tsuruga direction on Koshu Road)

A short while after passing the Windmill Village (Fusyamura), you will see the Lake Biwa Children's Land (Biwako Kodomo no Kuni). Shirahamaso is approximately 4.4km past the Lake Biwa Children's Land.
